TODAY'S FOCUS

Today we observe Sunday #2 of a five-Sunday stretch focusing on what is called Christ's "Bread of Life" sermon.

Last week we heard the event that spawned the Bread of Life sermon: the miraculous feeding of the 5000.

Each segment of the sermon will give us its own unique emphasis. Today, we hear Jesus declare that anything you work for eventually spoils. But what God gives (namely, Christ and everything that belongs to Him) endures forever.

The first two Scripture readings (from Exodus and 1 Corinthians) reveal that it was Christ Himself, not merely physical bread, that preserved and sustained the Old Testament Israelites on their 40-year journey through the desert wilderness to the Promised Land.

Christ says the Sacrament is an expression of unity (1 Co 10:16-17). We WANT to be unified with you on the basis of Christ and His doctrine!
