TODAY'S FOCUS

Today is the fifth and final Sunday in which we are focusing on Christ's "Bread of Life" sermon. *Lord, to whom shall we go?* Peter asked Jesus. When other disciples abandoned Jesus, the Twelve remained with Him because *You have the words of the eternal life.* Today's Scripture readings set before us the two paths: abandon the things of this world to cling to Christ and salvation, or cling to the things of this world and abandon Christ and salvation.

PLEASE RESPECT OUR PRACTICE OF "CLOSE COMMUNION"

Christ says the Sacrament is an expression of unity (1 Co 10:16-17). We WANT to be unified with you on the basis of Christ and His doctrine! Honesty compels us to ask you to WAIT before communing with us: 1) until you've had a chance to find out what we teach; 2) until you make your unity with us evident by membership at Peace.
